



**Parking:** For those driving there are some free car parks on campus. For more details see [the information on the Warwick website](#).

**By train:** The nearest train station to the university is in Coventry, but it is just as easy to get to from Leamington. It's probably best to go to whichever town you are staying in.

From Leamington you can get the U1 or the 12 buses to get to the university campus. These can be got from the bus stop just over the crossroads from the station, make sure the buses are in the direction of 'university.' A timetable can be found [here](#).

From Coventry the only bus you can get is the 12, this can be caught on Warwick road which can be reached by turning left out of the station and following the track until you go up some stairs onto the main road. These buses a frequent whatever day of the week.

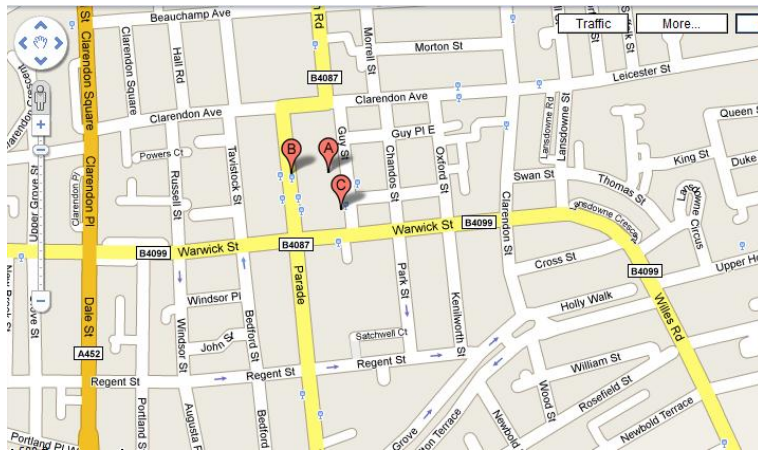
